What do you like most about Binbrook C of E Primary School?

My child has made amazing progress since being here...

Everyone in the school pushes my child to be the best he can be, making sure he is given extra support when needed...I can't praise them enough.

We've just had a parent-teacher meeting. My son's teacher explained his learning to me and suggested things I can do to help him. I was given a summary on paper helpful so I could share it with my partner.

Relationships between staff and pupils are nurturing and smaller group sizes allow teachers to know pupils well.

SLT are available quickly alongside teachers to discuss any concerns/ask questions.

The office/admin team are lovely. They really go above and beyond and make a real difference and impact on the feel and culture of the school.

All staff are approachable and the children are happy and therefore ready to learn.

If I have an issue, teachers get in touch with me very quickly. This never happened at my daughter's last school!

All children are treated respectfully and seen as individuals.

It's a welcoming, safe learning environment where children thrive.

Small, staff make most of rural setting.

Our son has extra needs and the school has gone above and beyond to make adaptations for him. He loves going to school!

The school takes great care of my child, whilst encouraging her to study and helping her in lessons. Lovely atmosphere. Thank you!

Fluffy Friday, how friendly it is, art, lots going on i.e. trips, visiting iSingPOP, authors, Den Man, Pantomime etc.

The school is very friendly. Pre-school is a benefit to the school and we'd like more hours to be offered.

The teachers all "hand over" the children to parents at end of day and are very good at communicating how the day has gone and taking time to talk with us if we have a query.

How can we make Binbrook C of E Primary even better?

Communication and consistency between lunchtime staff/support staff/teachers to ensure children are receiving consistent language/encouragement from all staff.

Ensure all rewards are accessible for every pupil – effort based instead of skill based – trying to earn a pen license has caused my child distress.

Homework is not always age friendly (and they expect too much!).

Bring back Maypole as this was a tradition the school should never have stopped. After school clubs instead of payed raparound care. More preperation for senior school. More Charity Days. More homework including spellings. Improve Sports Day.

More space for rest of school (not footballers) during second break.

Consider alternative sponsorship instead of C of E.

Bring back Gardening Club.

Rat run outside main doors.

More time for football during second break – when it has been barred it has been very stressful.

We have to ask how children are getting on unless it's parents evening and then its bits of paper.

We don't have any issues with the school because we know that if we ever do think of things to be done we know we can approach them at any time to voice this.
