

Parent and Carers Feedback Sheet

Tuesday 4th November 2025

As part of our commitment to seeking the views of parents and carers, the Governors of Binbrook Church of England Primary School appreciate you taking the time to talk to them.

We'll use the comments to measure what is working well and what we need to improve upon and to give parents and carers the opportunity to put forward ideas or suggestions for school improvement.

The discussions were of an informal nature with no defined topics. However, discussions were initiated through topics including wrap-around provision, extra-curricular opportunities, and communication with the school regarding a child's progress.

General comments:

- Communication with the School, and with all members of staff was considered to be very good by all parents. Teaching staff were deemed to be accessible, approachable and supportive. Any issues that parents had with their child were managed efficiently and promptly; parents considered that the teaching staff would 'listen' to their concerns.
- When asked 'how good is the school' communication featured as one of the first two comments made, and included both the face-to-face meetings as well as information provided by the on-line, Parent Hub.
- The communication between parents, the School, and outside agencies was remarked upon in two instances as being constructive and welcome.
- General comments on the school – it was a warm and welcoming place for children to learn; children were happy; children were making good progress. *(It did appear that the parents interviewed, had a greater understanding of where their child was in terms of progress made and what the word 'expected' meant.)*
- There were a small number of comments on the wraparound provision. Whilst the offering and the opportunities for the children was thought to be good, the negative comments were focused on the fact that parents were being charged for the provision.
- Two parents expressed an intention of applying for the two vacant roles as parent governors.
