School Uniform

The pupils, staff and the Governors at Binbrook Church of England Primary School value and take pride in our schools' dress code and believe that uniform nurtures a sense of belonging. We therefore require your support in providing and encouraging the wearing of school uniform throughout the school day.

Wearing school uniform relates to our school value of respect; of the school, of the uniform and of ourselves.

The Uniform

All children are required to wear Binbrook Church of England Primary School uniform.

Whilst we ask that the sweatshirt/cardigan purchased features the school logo, this is the only branded item we request. All other items are generic, therefore expenditure on school uniform is not excessive for parents (parents have a choice whether to purchase a P.E. shirt with the school logo or a plain P.E. shirt).

Provision of second-hand uniforms

Second-hand uniforms can benefit all parents. In addition, by extending the life of garments, it is more sustainable.

Second-hand uniforms are available in this school at no cost and hang on the rail in the main entrance to the school. We have other items (in a variety of sizes), stored elsewhere in school.

We are also keen to take in uniform that any child has grown out of (and is in a wearable condition), in order to replenish the stock overtime.

School Uniform consists of:

- White shirt or polo shirt (T-Shirt are not allowed)
- Maroon sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo (not red)
- Black or grey trousers, shorts or skirts
- Summer dress (a red check gingham/striped)
- Flat black school shoes

Please note that the following are not permitted in school

- High heels, heels or trainings shoes
- Extreme hair styles
- Large or excessive hair accessories
- Earrings other than stud earrings

Indoor PE and Games Uniform:

Maroon shorts and maroon PE shirt with school logo or plain white t-shirt
Plimsolls
Named P.E bag
Hair Tie for long hair

Outdoor PE and Games Uniform:

The same uniform as indoor P.E. but also training shoes
A tracksuit for the colder months
Sun hats/caps for the summer months
Hair tie for long hair if required

For Swimming:

One-piece costume or
swimming trunks
Hair tie for long hair
Towel
Brush or comb
Goggles (optional)

Make Up:

This must not be worn in school by any child, including nail polish on fingers or toes.

Jewellery:

Children may wear stud earrings if they wish. Other types of earrings in school can be dangerous and may not be worn. Children should not wear any other form of jewellery including rings and chains. Children must be able to remove earrings on their own in order to take part in Physical Education. If they cannot do so, earrings must be covered up with plasters provided from home.

Religion:

If there is a religious reason for a piece of jewellery or clothing to be worn please discuss this with the head teacher.

SEND:

If your child needs a reasonable adjustment to the uniform policy for due to any special needs they may have, for example sensory issues, please contact our SENDco to discuss this fully.
