

Class Foxes Curriculum Overview – Summer 2, 2026

A brief summary of what the children will be covering in Class Foxes this term

English

This term we will be continuing our focus on reading by teaching the children new vocabulary and comprehension skills. As usual, we will be looking at fiction and Non-Fiction texts to provide stimulus for writing and will be teaching the children to learn and use the SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) skills taught in a variety of writing genres. Our Class Reader this term will be classic text 'Around the World in 80 days' by Jules Verne.

Mathematics

This term in Class Foxes we will aim to deepen and consolidate much of the learning we have done over the year through investigation and problem solving. The children will be encouraged to apply their knowledge to reason as discuss their understanding. Any misconceptions or gaps in understanding will be addressed accordingly.

Forest School

This term we will visit the woods at Wold Newton for our Forest school sessions. In these sessions, children are taught to develop their social & emotion skills.

Science - In science this term we will continue to study the topic 'Properties and Changes of Materials'. This will involve using their knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.

Geography Energy and the Environment In this unit we will learn about where our power and food comes from and how it is made and distributed. We will look at the difference between renewable and non-renewable sources of electricity and think about the sustainability of what we use. We will incorporate a trip to the Energy From Waste visitor centre to learn about how general waste is processed to produce power and waste management in Lincolnshire.

Computing

Children will be learning to create a program to run on a controllable device. They will be taught to explain that selection can control the flow of a program which will help them to design their own program.

PHSE/ RSE

We will be looking at 'Changing Me'. This will include learning about changes during puberty, conception and pregnancy. We will also look at the emotional challenges pressures that may come with this.

Important information

In class Foxes, **homework** will usually go out twice a week to be returned either at the beginning or the end of the week. Children should read at home daily if possible, please help support and/or encourage them to do this. **It is a good idea for P.E. kits to stay in school for the week and/ or term.** This should help children to have PE kits readily available. Trainers need to be available on a daily basis for playground apparatus. Children will need to come to school in Forest school clothing on Mondays (from 15th June).

The children will be looking at various art and design technique through the lens of 'The Seaside'. As well as learning and practising various art techniques, they will look at various artists to observe best practice.

RE - This term's topic is 'What do people believe about peace?' We will look at the idea of peace across and within a variety of religions.

In PE curriculum time we will be focusing on the various skills needed to play a wide range of sports. They will be encouraged to develop a positive attitude towards sport and physical activity to help them lead a vibrant and healthy lifestyle.
