1. Locational Knowledge

Compared to Lower KS2, I focus more on finding locations outside of the UK. I can begin to explore Eastern Europe and South America using maps to find these locations. I can use my knowledge of longitude, latitude, coordinates and indexes to locate places.

2. Place Knowledge

I develop my analytical skills by comparing areas of the UK with areas outside of the UK. I will have a deeper knowledge of diverse places, people, resources, natural, and human environments. I can make links to places outside of the UK and where I live. I conduct independent research, asking and answering questions.

3. Human & Physical Geography

I can deepen my understanding of the difference between physical and human geography. I can explain the terminology of both aspects of geography with a range of examples. I spend time exploring human geography and the impact humans have on the world. I focus on trade links, resources and the distribution of resources around the world.

4. Geography Skills & Fieldwork

I build on my map skills by communicating locations through grid references and coordinates. I can also explain what makes a good map symbol and why. I can focus on observing and recording the changes of human features over time, for example trade patterns.
