2. Place Knowledge

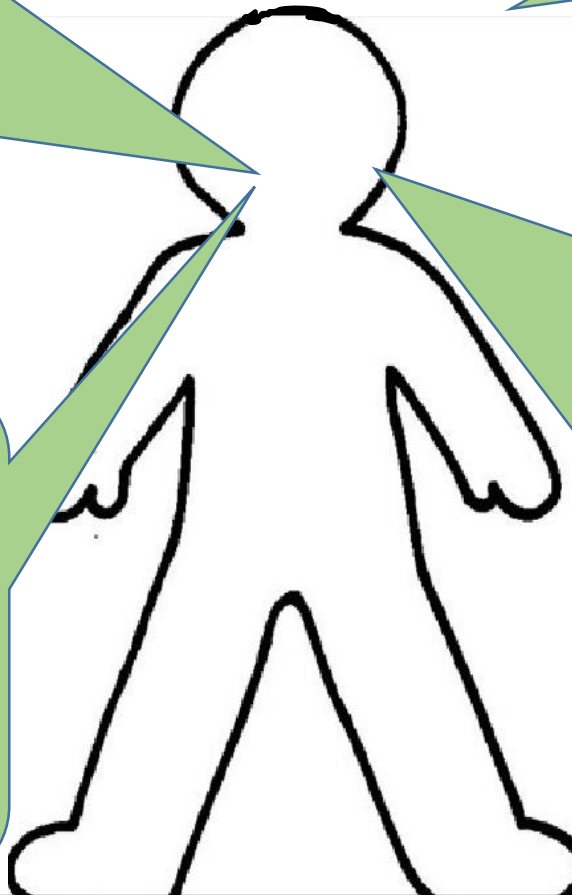
